First login to the computer

On Linux please sign-in with the Guest-Account (without any password) On Windows use your own account and the password 'unsicher' to sign-in. The password has to be changed at the first login.

Kerberos-registration

Please start a webbrowser and enter the following web address:

At this page please register with your university's identifier (beginning with 'fm...') You need the university identifier together with the password that you received when signing the employment contract. RRZ-password)

Changing the Kerberos-password

You can change your password at the following web address:

https://www.math.uni-hamburg.de/it/passwd

At the webpage your Kerberos-password as well as the RRZ-password (password of the local computing centre) for Email and WLAN will be changed. Please follow the recommendations for password-security on the webpage. For Windows-users we suggest to use the same password for computer-login as for Kerberos.

Email / Webmail

Via the Webmail-interface of the RRZ (local computing centre) you can send and receive Emails: https://webmail.rrz.uni-hamburg.de (login with university identifier and RRZ-password). Nevertheless we recommend the use of the 'Thunderbird'-mailing-program at the Mathematics department.

AFS-Homedirectory:

At the Mathematics department we utilize the AFS-network-filesystem. This means, that your home-directory isn't constrained to your local computer. Thus you can access your data from any computer (including your computer at home). On a Windows-system this requires that you store all your data to drive 'H:'. On a Linux-system the AFS will be used automatically.
