

Instructions for the Colloquium on Kähler Geometry and Mathematical Physics

Conference location

The colloquium ‘Kähler Geometry and Mathematical Physics’ celebrating Erich Kähler’s 100th birthday on the occasion of Oswald Riemenschneider’s 65th birthday takes place at the main building of Hamburg University, located in Edmund-Siemers-Allee 1 (see also the green star in the enclosed map). On Friday all talks shall be in lecture hall B, on Saturday they shall be all in lecture hall C: just follow the signs. The conference location is a two minutes walk from the Dammtor train station (which is served by both long distance trains and suburban trains, called S-Bahn) and the underground station Stephansplatz for line U1.

Arriving by train

Most but not all long-distance trains stop at Dammtor station. If you are in doubt, please check with the conductor. Both Hamburg central station (Hauptbahnhof) and Hamburg Altona station have frequent S-Bahn connections to Dammtor station. In the Dammtor station, go down from the platform and turn north-east, following the signs Edmund-Siemers-Allee/Universität. In front of the Dammtor station, turn left and walk down Edmund-Siemers-Allee for about 50 meters: you will find yourself right in front of the main building of the University.

Arriving by plane

You can take a taxi (the distance is about 10 kilometers). Due to frequent traffic jams, however, public transport will be quicker during most periods of the day.

For public transport, leave the terminal. Between terminal 1 and 2, there is the stop of bus line 110. It leaves every ten minutes between 5.41 a.m. and 11.11 p.m. Take it to its terminal station, U/S Ohlsdorf (after about 12 minutes drive). At U Ohlsdorf, take the line U1 direction Wandsbek Markt, Wandsbek-Gartenstadt, Farmsen, Volksdorf, Ohlstedt, or Großhansdorf. Get off at the

stop Stephansplatz (after about 14 minutes ride). Leaving the underground station, walk north to the Dammtor station, taking a little bridge for pedestrians. Cross Dammtor station, following the signs Edmund-Siemers-Allee/Universität. After having crossed the Dammtor station, turn left and walk down Edmund-Siemers-Allee for about 50 meters: you will find yourself right in front of the main building of the University.

Visitors in the DESY hostel

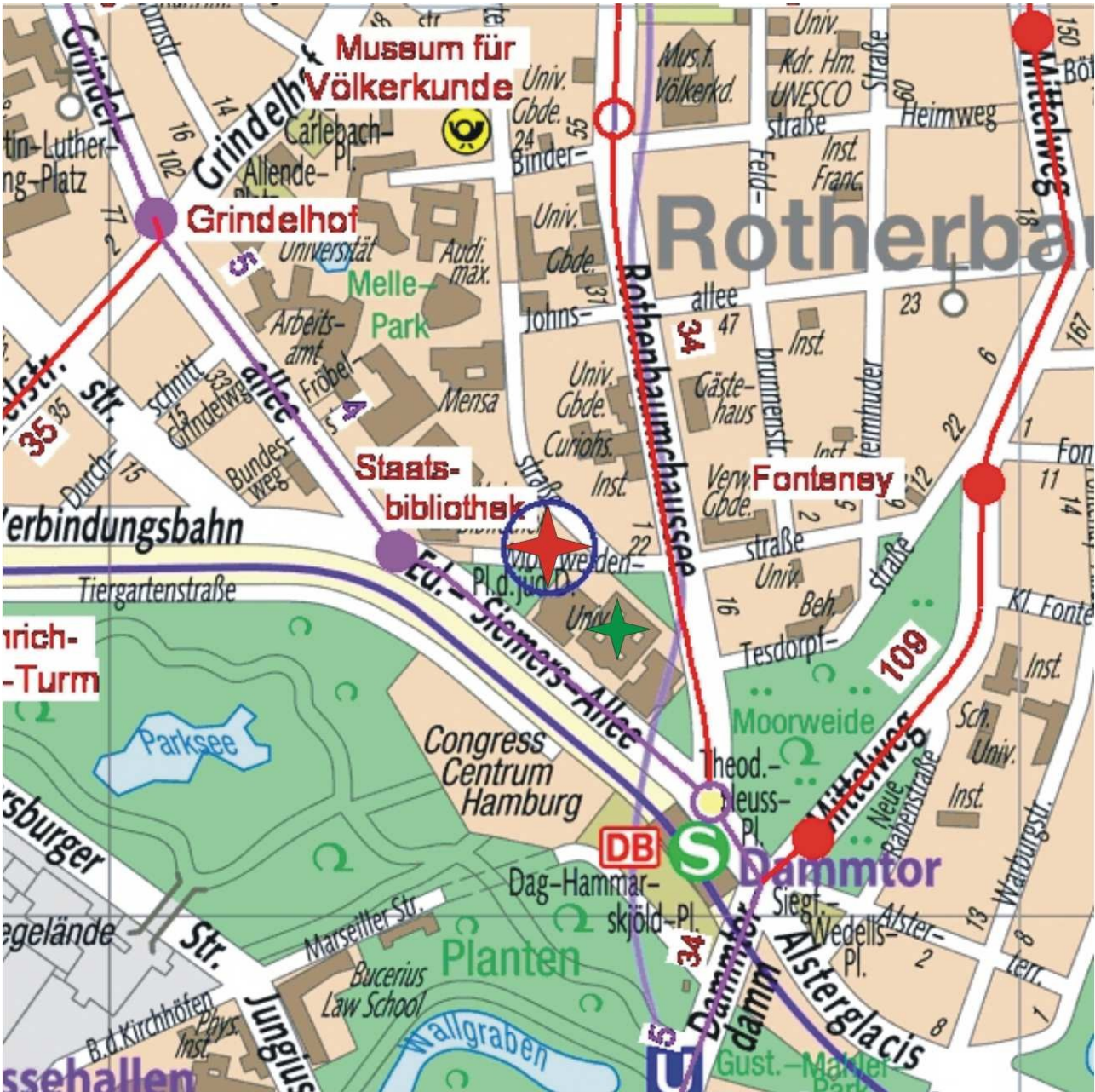
To go from DESY to the conference location, leave DESY by the main entrance. Take bus number 1 to the stop S Othmarschen (8 minutes drive, every ten minutes). Take there the suburban train S1 to Altona (6 minutes ride). Change in Altona to the suburban train S31 to Dammtor (9 minutes ride). The total time for the ride is about 30 minutes.
